
ALTERNATE BRANCHING – COMPOUND LEAVES


















ALTERNATE BRANCHING - SIMPLE LOBED LEAVES

NON-LOBED LEAVES WITH FLATTENED STEMS





CONIFERS – NEEDLE-SHAPED LEAVES


