## Agriculture

Agriculture enhances the quality of life in the Municipality of Port Hope and Northumberland County by the products it contributes to the marketplace and by preserving our rural countryside and a traditional Canadian way of life. Pick-your-own and ready-picked farm fresh outlets dot the countryside offering farm produce ranging from sweet corn to strawberries, from apples to maple syrup.

Major agricultural operations are also a part of the local economy including Curtis Chicks, a chicken hatchery and Ganaraska Grain which handles, cleans, dries, stores and trucks over 26,000 tonnes of grain per year.

**The Port Hope Farmer's Market** provides locally grown beef, lamb, vegetables, fruit, flowers and herbs along with homemade preserves, pastries, baked goods and breads. The Farmers Market is open May to October – Saturday mornings behind Town Hall, 56 Queen Street and Wednesday afternoons in the parking lot of Home Hardware, 177 Toronto Road.
