Port Hope Medical Centre

The Municipality of Port Hope offers a full range of medical services. The Port Hope Medical Centre is a modern, centrally located facility with family doctors, dentists, counseling services, lab, X-ray, optometry, podiatry, pharmacy and walk-in clinic.

Hospitals

Our regional hospital, The Northumberland Hills Hospital, is located at 1000 DePalma Drive Cobourg, just a short 10 minute drive from Port Hope. The new facility has 137 beds and provides a full range of medical services including a cardiac clinic, rehabilitation and speech therapy, ophthalmology, Women's Health Care Centre, palliative care unit, surgical, obstetrical, pediatric, ambulatory, diagnostic imaging including CT scan, MRI, Dialysis, Chemotherapy and emergency care.

Other hospital facilities nearby include: Lakeridge Health in Bowmanville (20 minute drive), Regional facilities in both Peterborough and Oshawa (30 minutes' drive), and Sunnybrook Health Science Center, a major hospital and trauma center, is less than one hour away.

Port Hope Community Health Centre

Located at 99 Toronto Road, the Port Hope CHC is a non-profit, healthcare and support service centre, providing a range of health services including primary care illness prevention and health promotion. The Port Hope CHC serves residents within a 50 kilometre radius with special consideration given to: Seniors with more than one chronic disease, youth at risk between the ages of 12 to 21, those struggling with mental health or addictions, and those receiving social assistance or on a fixed income.

Haliburton Kawartha Pine Ridge District Health Unit

The Haliburton Kawartha Pine Ridge District Health Unit has an office located in Port Hope. The HKPR District Health Unit works with the residents of communities to help prevent illness, protect against disease and promote healthy lifestyles. The Unit provides support and guidance on a variety of public health issues including nutrition, physical activity, and substance abuse. They monitor water quality, inspect food premises, approve septic systems and investigate environmental hazards. In addition, the Unit works to prevent the spread of communicable diseases through immunization and infection control programs. The Unit provides resources, education, guidance, programs and information to the residents of the community.
